Patient care and comfort <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Explanation of procedures to the patient b. Independent positioning 2. Basic normal ultrasound examinations <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Obtain appropriate requisitions for procedures b. Verification of patient to procedure c. Enter patient demographics into ultrasound system independently 3. Participation in the daily operation of a typical ultrasound department 4. Application of pertinent policies related to patient care 5. Identification of pertinent patient history data 6. Performance of the following exams/views <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Cardiac anatomical structures b. PLAX View, RVIT and PSAX to identify cardiac structures c. Apical 4, 5, 2 and 3 chamber views d. Two dimensional and Doppler (pulsed wave, continuous wave and color flow) diagnostic procedures 7. Identification of normal cardiac structures and flow patterns 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. An overall score of 73% or better on combined weekly evaluations of scanning ability. 2. An overall score of 73% or better on combined weekly evaluations of scanning ability with respect to discovering and demonstrating basic pathologic processes. 3. An overall score of 73% or better on combined weekly evaluations of departmental participation. 4. An overall score of 73% or better on combined weekly evaluations of the application of patient-related policies. 5. An overall score of 73% or better on combined weekly evaluations of the student's patient care skills. 6. An overall score of 73% or better on combined weekly evaluations of the student's ability to present a case to the supervising physician. <p>Note: Evaluations are performed on a weekly basis by clinical instructors at the student's clinical rotation site.</p>
