Course Description, Prerequisite, Corequisite:

ART-104- DRAWING COMPOSITION-3 credits (formerly ARTS-149)

This intermediate studio course is a continuation of Drawing 1. Emphasis will be placed on developing dynamic compositions, perceptual awareness, and critical self-evaluation, as means towards growth in one's abilities in visual self-expression. Five in-class hours weekly.PREREQUISITE: ART-102 or permission of instructor. COREQUISITE: ART-104L Mass Transfer Block: Credits earned in this course are counted towards the MassTransfer Block Humanities and Fine Arts requirements.

Course Objectives

By the end of ART-104, the student will elaborate on the skills and concepts from ART-102, and:

- 1. Demonstrate advanced understanding of,
 - A. Materials and Mediums (graphite, ink, paper, and possibly pastel, colored pencil) used in drawing.
 - B. Technical Processes (shading, mixing colors with dry media) used in drawing.
 - C. Aesthetic Elements (color, composition) used in drawing.
- 2. Apply safe and effective use of studio space and materials.
- 3. Exemplify an advanced standard of craftsmanship and work ethic.
- 4. Engage in sophisticated strategies for generating and developing concepts and imagery in relation to drawing.
- 5. Participate in the creative process of imagining, designing, creating, and sharing drawings.
- 6. Critique and explain the visual elements they see in their drawings and those of their peers.
- 7. Appreciate and critically compare drawing techniques throughout history and in contemporary art as they pertain to class assignments.
- 8. Submit a portfolio of drawings in an organized and professional manner.
