At the completion of the Nursing program, our students will be able to do the following:

1. Analyze the application of knowledge in the provision of care of individuals and families with multisystem healthcare problems (Nursing Knowledge).
2. Evaluate compassionate, culturally appropriate, and safe care that recognizes individual and family preferences, values and needs (Patient Centered Care).
3. Model professional standards of nursing practice (Professionalism).
