<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ To model effective partnering in scene work through mutual trust, support for objectives, preparedness, responsible attendance/punctuality and free and open communication.</li> </ul>	1. Students will be required to develop and perform scenes with a single partner and group scenes with 4 or more actors.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ To increase one's perception of an actor's performance and be able to evaluate it critically.</li> </ul>	1. Students will be assigned to provide a structured and critical evaluation of well-known actors and peer actors.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ To develop a better awareness of theatrical excellence and an interest in experiencing theatre more fully.</li> </ul>	1. Students will be required to attend STCC Theater performances and write a review of the play.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Critical Thinking: To develop a disciplined, self-directed, systematic framework for thinking and problem solving appropriate to the situation</li> </ul>	1. Students will write papers on performance analysis, both of themselves, and their peers.
