Course Title: Basic Design II Semester: Spring Year: 2015

#### Course Description, Prerequisite, Corequisite:

ART-103-BASIC DESIGN II- 3 credits (*formerly ARTS-246*)

This intermediate studio course focuses on color theory in art and design. Students will become critically aware of the way artists influence the viewer with color through a series of projects focusing on various materials, mediums, technical processes, and aesthetic principles common in art. Five in-class hours weekly. Prerequisite(s): ART-101. Corequisite(s): ART-103L. Mass Transfer Block: Credits earned in this course are counted towards the MassTransfer Block Humanities and Fine Arts requirements.

#### Course Objectives

By the end of ART-103, the student will:

1. Demonstrate a basic understanding of,
  - A. A variety of *Materials and Mediums* used to apply color to a surface.
  - B. *Technical Processes* (color mixing, application techniques) used in art and design.
  - C. *Aesthetic Elements* (color perception, color wheel, depth, transparency, psychological impact of color) used in art and design.
2. Apply safe and effective use of studio space and materials.
3. Exemplify an advanced standard of craftsmanship and work ethic.
4. Participate in the creative process of *imagining, designing, creating, and sharing* artwork.
5. Critique and explain the visual elements they see in their work and that of their peers.
6. Appreciate and critically compare color in art and design throughout history and in contemporary art as they pertain to class assignments.
7. Submit a portfolio of projects in an organized and professional manner.
