Course Description, Prerequisite, Corequisite: Students will use effective vocal techniques to sing in ensemble and solo performances. Through singing exercises, students will work to improve their breathing, pitch, posture, expression and knowledge of musical theory. Students will practice a variety of songs, culminating in a final recital. Mass Transfer Block: Credits earned in this course are counted towards the MassTransfer Block Humanities and Fine Arts requirements.
