## **Course Description, Prerequisite, Corequisite:**

ART-103-BASIC DESIGN II- 3 credits (formerly ARTS-246)

This intermediate studio course focuses on color theory in art and design. Students will become critically aware of the way artists influence the viewer with color through a series of projects focusing on various materials, mediums, technical processes, and aesthetic principles common in art. Five in-class hours weekly.Prerequisite(s): ART-101. Corequisite(s): ART-103L. Mass Transfer Block: Credits earned in this course are counted towards the MassTransfer Block Humanities and Fine Arts requirements.

## **Course Objectives**

By the end of ART-103, the student will:

- 1. Demonstrate a basic understanding of,
  - A. A variety of *Materials and Mediums* used to apply color to a surface.
  - B. Technical Processes (color mixing, application techniques) used in art and design.
  - C. Aesthetic Elements (color perception, color wheel, depth, transparency, psychological impact of color) used in art and design.
- 2. Apply safe and effective use of studio space and materials.
- 3. Exemplify an advanced standard of craftsmanship and work ethic.
- 4. Participate in the creative process of *imagining*, *designing*, *creating*, *and sharing* artwork.
- 5. Critique and explain the visual elements they see in their work and that of their peers.
- 6. Appreciate and critically compare color in art and design throughout history and in contemporary art as they pertain to class assignments.
- 7. Submit a portfolio of projects in an organized and professional manner.
